NOTICE OF INFORMATION SESSION Traffic Signal Operations and Support Contracts Office of Traffic Operations

The Georgia Department of Transportation (Department), Office of Traffic Operations, is conducting an information session to share our visions for the future of traffic signal operations in Georgia and answer questions about the three (3) new traffic signal operations contracts for the metro Atlanta area and the two (2) statewide traffic signal operations support contracts.

The Department intends to award five (5) contracts related to traffic signal operations in calendar year 2020. In an effort to provide potential Proposers with a better understanding of the needs of these contracts, the Department has scheduled an information session on May 27th, 2020 from 1:00pm to 3:00pm.
